Troubleshooting USB to RS-232 Adapter Connection to Windows PC

Subject: Troubleshooting if Windows PC Does Not Recognize USB to RS-232 Adapter

Summary: Depending on the OS, some Windows PCs do not recognize the USB to RS-232 adapter that connects the computer with your McLane instrument. This adapter is included in the instrument toolkit.

Actions: Installing a driver on the Windows PC can fix this issue:

- Unplug the USB to RS-232 Adapter
- Locate the file CDM21228 Setup.exe included on the USB drive sent with your product shipment.
- Run CDM21228 Setup.exe on your Windows computer.
- Plug the USB to RS-232 Adapter into any available USB port
- Use the new COM port available when the driver installation in complete.
