Instrument: MMP with Sea-Bird 52MP CTD

Subject: Removing the Sea-Bird 52MP CTD Sensor

**Summary:** A releasable polyethylene support strut on the MMP eases removal of the Sea-Bird 52MP CTD.

**Potential Negative Effects:** Strut must be re-installed properly before deployment for MMP structural

integrity.

**Technical Details:** The 52MP CTD fits below a removable strut on the MMP body. When removing the 52MP CTD, refer to the photos and steps that follow as a guide.




Figure 1: 52MP CTD and Removable Strut





Figure 2: Strut with Notch Facing Up

1. Turn the strut so that the notch faces up (see Figure 2).




Figure 3: Release the Strut

- 2. Use a 3/8" Hex Driver to remove the socket cap screw from the strut bottom (see Figure 3).
- 3. Lift up to remove the strut (see Figure 4).




Figure 5: Remove Mounting Plate Screws

4. Remove the CTD mounting bracket screws using an Allen wrench (see Figure 5).

**Note:** Support the CTD sensor while removing the screws.

- 5. Carefully lift the 52MP CTD and mounting bracket from the MMP (see Figure 6).
- 6. Disconnect the MMP CTD cable.
- 7. Reverse these steps to re-install the CTD.
